As we strive to build our selves and the Farm into a modern industry, we shall be adopting modern ways of dealing with safety of individual and property. This document shall be governed by the laws of the land and enforced by all layers of safety on site, the authorities and courts of law.

Abstract

This section of our evolving rules and regulation at the farm shall be aimed at ensuring that the contractors, their employees and subcontractors adhere to the rules of the site. Jozzy Farm reserves the right to terminate association, employment or relations with offenders without pay or retribution. The Farm shall free itself from individuals / companies that don't want to move on the rails.

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Contractors

These rules apply to all contractors, sub-contractors, self-employed persons and consultants who may do work for Jozzy Farm Uganda on a permanent or re-occurring basis.

In the following set down rules, the term “contractor” means any person contracted to do work for the Farm.

- a) Contractors will ensure that all site personnel are notified of any hazards which evolve on site. Stating how work will progress while the hazard is present, along with instructions of what to do in an emergency.
- b) Contractor's plant and equipment must be in a good working condition and kept maintained in safe manner.
- c) Contractors will at the end of each day, make sure that the site is clear of materials, plant or equipment which could cause damage to site personnel or others who may have access to the site.
- d) Contractors working above ground level must ensure that adequate precautions are taken and that 'Jozzy Farm's site management have approved these measures before any work commences'.
- e) Contractors' employees must use protective safety clothes or equipment required by any statutory regulation, code of practice or 'safety rule' in the following sections.
- f) Contractors carrying out electrical or mechanical work on behalf of Jozzy Farm must make that particular job 'safe' by means of total isolation, i.e.
 1. Electrical circuits must be isolated by the electrician by means of removal of fuses and locked off at the control board and the electrician attaching his own personal padlock onto the control panel door.

2. Mechanical installation or repairs must be isolated as above, by getting an electrician to do the isolation, but, the mechanical engineer must then attach his own personal padlock to the control panel door bracket. This way it ensures that to make the circuit 'live' requires both persons in full agreement about the safety of the circuit being put back into use.

g) Any accident or dangerous occurrence must be reported immediately, to Jozzy Farm management as well as the appropriate section of the Farm Inspectorate or supervisors.

As we generate the safety policy on the Farm, we will be amending this document from time to time to add material or remove. It's up to the users to check for changes and acquaint themselves with the information.
